

ARRISA Programme

Purpose: Pseudonymised personal and health data will be used to inform the ARRISA project. The data will only be extracted for patients who meet the strict criteria. The project will assist with the NHS management and treatment of patients with Asthma. Data will be shared with NHS Digital to enable linkage with other data relating to those patients.

No patient data will be shared if a Type 1 or National data opt out is applied to their record.

Legal Basis : while the activity is to assist with the direct care of patients in managing asthma this project has also been approved via the CAG.

The transfer of personal data by participating GP practices to Harvey Walsh Ltd, for transfer to NHS Digital and record linkage with secondary care data is lawful under General Data Protection Regulation Article 9 (2) (j), and Article 6 (1)(e). Processing is considered to be in the public interest under Section 251 of the National Health Service Act 2006 (HRA Confidentiality Advisory Group approval ref. 18CAG1085).
